Dr. Mrityunjay Athreya, after Graduating from Stanford and Harvard, left the promising options of a career in industry and the civil service, joined the faculty of the IIM, Kolkata in 1967. Dr. Mrityunjay Athreya has contributed more than three and half decades in management education, training, research and consultancy, which, made him as one of the founders and pioneers of the Indian management movement in industry, central and state governments, apex and local chambers of commerce and industry, professional associations; and NGO's. He is also a Gold Medallist from ICWAI (India) and IMA London. He has been a Visiting Professor at the London and Scottish Business Schools. Dr. Athreya advises to Indian firms and MNC's on Visioning, Strategic Planning, OD and HRD, which made them to reach new heights globally. Dr. Athreya has been Chairman and Member of several government committees on Policy and Restructuring, including Telecom, Oil, Banking and Civil Aviation. As the Chairman of the committee on Telecom modernization and reforms in 1991, he has set the agenda for the telecom privatization and growth of recent years, enabling India's Communication revolution and global recognition.

Dr. Athreya is the Founder-President of Sampradaan, the Indian Centre for Philanthropy, a non-profit NGO whose mission is to re-create a caring, sharing and compassionate society, by advocating good giving by Corporates and high network individuals. He is part of a global movement on integrating spirituality into life and the work place. He is Chairman of the Sringeri Institute of Management in Delhi, blending global contemporary management with relevant insights from the Indic heritage of yoga, meditation, karma yoga and advaita for global harmony, in a tormented world.
